
RABINDRANATH TAGORE

The Great Poet of India

Rabindranath Tagore was born in the Tagore family of Jorasanko in 1861. His family was well known for its cultural achievements. He was the youngest son of Maharishi Devendranath Tagore.



He was educated mostly at home under private tutors and for one year in the university college in London. He started composing poem at the age of seven.

Tagore's poems regularly appeared in Bharathi's Bengal literary monthly magazine in 1885, He became the editor of Balak, a Bengali monthly Magazine for the youngsters. Later, he edited "Sadhana" and Bangadarshan and two other journals.

Tagore also wrote novels, short stories, travel accounts musical plays and symbolic dramas, essays and songs of the highest caliber. He wrote plays and staged them himself. His style in music is called Rabindar sangeet.

Tagore took painting, in the years of his life and produced nearly 3,000 pictures in the later most modern styles. He was one of the best creative painters of modern India.

Tagore's works have been translated into all the major languages of the world. They have brought Joy, solace and strength to millions of people in India and abroad. His major works are Gitanjali, Malini, Manasi etc.

SYLLABUS

ADMISSION

SCHOOL WORKING HOURS

The morning assembly commences at 9 a.m. All the students should be present in their respective classrooms by 8.50 a.m. in order to march for the assembly.

Classes K.G. to V will work from Monday to Friday. VI to X will work from Monday to Saturday

Weekly 48 periods for VI to X std and 35 periods for K.G. to V std classes are conducted with 40 minutes duration.

ATTENDANCE

No pupil shall be absent himself /herself without obtaining leave from the Principal. Application for leave shall be made by the father or mother only. If a student is continuously absent for 15 days without a leave letter his/her name will be struck off from the rolls. Re admission will be made on payment of fine. No pupil will be sent home

On all the other working days parents of all classes can meet the teachers between 3.45 and 4.15 p.m.

PARENTS CO-OPERATION

To maintain high standard and discipline the co-operation of the parents is highly solicited.

Parents are requested to

- 1. Ensure regular attendance of the children
- 2. Send the students to school always in full uniform neat and tidy.
- 3. Make regular and timely payments of school fees without reminders, For reminder letters and SMS, charges will be levied.
 - 4. Attend parent teachers meet
- 5. Make proper note of the remarks made in the progress report.
- 6. Meet the Principal, co-ordinator and discuss the progress of their children between 3.00 & 4.00 p.m.on any working day.
- 7. Send the Mid-day meal through their wards in the morning itself and students are stricly not allowed to go out of the school premises during lunch break.
- 8. Keep their wards ready to board the school bus at fixed centre and at fixed timings.
- 9. In the case of any suggestion of grievance about their wards education, parents are requested to give through suggestion farms readily available in school office.

No refund or adjustment of school fee once paid shall be made under any circumstances.

While paying the school fee students must bring their fees card compulsorily.

DATE OF PAYMENT

Every month before 7th fee is payable only by cash.

CONVEYANCE

The school provides bus facilities to students. We cover 20 - 25 km around Tindivanam. The charges are fixed according to the distance.

The charges are payable every month, for belated payment of bus fees Rs.50/- is charged as fine every month.

TEXT BOOKS

All textbooks and notebooks will be supplied from the school for the convenience of the students.

WITHDRAWALS

Application for T.C. should be made to the Principal from the 30th March 2019 No.T.C.will be issued at any other time. How ever it may be issued at the discretion of the Principal after the last date only on payment of first term fees & Special fees for the year.

INTERVIEWS

The parents can meet the Principal between 3.30 to 4.30 p.m.Parents of L.K.G. to V std can meet the teachers concerned between 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.on all working Saturdays.

during school hours. On the request of the parent, student will be allowed to leave in the middle.

UNIFORM

Students should come to school neat and tidy. Wearing of gold or fancy ornaments is strictly forbidden. Under no circumstances students shall be allowed to come to school without proper hair cut, school uniform, polished shoes etc.

DISCIPLINE

Discipline, orderliness and decorum are expected from students.

If a student becomes unmanageable and if his / her activities are detrimental to the interest of the school, the Principal has the right to dismiss the student from the school at any time of the year.

PROGRESS REPORT

Parents can have progress reports after every assessments and examination. Parents will study carefully the remarks made there in and do what is necessary to improve their wards in their weak subject or subjects in consultation with the Principal.

LIBRARY

The school has well stocked library with more than 2000 varieties of books and many magazines and periodicals. Books on various subjects are available to all the students. Students are allowed to take only one book at a time and return it. If the book is lost by the pupil the cost of the same will be recovered.

LABORATORY

The school has well equipped laboratory in Physics, Chemistry, Life Science, Mathematics & Computer Science. Students from V to X are allowed to do Practicals.

COMPUTER SCIENCE & SMART CLASS TECHNOLOGY

The school has well established and well furnished Computer Science Lab. Computerised Coaching is imparted from K.G. to X std. Computers with multimedia network have been installed to cater to the teaching of Computer Science. The projectors and screens are used by teachers to explain lessons using powerpoint and CDs. All the subjects are taught using the smart class technology. Our school was the 1st school to introduce computer Science in 1987 in our District It also introduced computer aided teaching & learning.

THE CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school has various co-curricular activities. The Science, Sports and fine arts club, literary association, scouts and guides etc, gives ample scope for the pupil to develop their talents. Students take part in various activities such as quiz, debate, dramatics, creative craft, essay writing and various competitions.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Visit to important places is encouraged. Independence day, Childrens day, Teachers day, Annual sports

day, Pongal celebration, Deepawali awareness programme, school anniversary etc., are celebrated and students are trained to display their talents on such occasions. Yoga, Karate, Chess and Music are included in the regular timetable.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We have 1.5 acres of land for playground at Karnavoor pattai, Tindivanam. Students are sent by our school van. 2 periods are allotted for physical education activities every week.

SCOUTS AND GUIDES

This school regularly trains the students through scouts and guides movements and presents the students for Rajya Puraskar Award and Rashtrapathy Awards.

SPECIAL CLASSES

Our school does not encourage private tuition at school. Special classes are conducted for the higher standard students prior to and after the school hours almost from the beginning of the academic year. These classes are compulsory.

SCHOOL FEES

The school fees is payable for all twelve months of the year starting from April. If the fee is not paid on or before the prescribed date, the pupil may pay their fees along with late fee of Rs. 100/- per month. If the fees is not paid consequitively for 3 months, a fine of Rs. 500/- will be charged at the 3rd month.
